Dr. Van Delinder's teaching and scholarship have focused on gender, race and the social psychology of protest. She recently served as PI on the OSU ADVANCE grant (NSF# 0820240) addressing the under-representation of women and minorities in academic STEM fields. In Spring 2016, she coordinated the administration of the COACHE survey (Collaborative on Academic Careers in Higher Education) of all full time tenure-track faculty. She recently chaired a task force to examine more closely the COACHE findings related to faculty work/life balance.
